The county has released its schedule for 2013 street repaving and a number of Lyon Village streets are affected. Before any work begins, the county will hang notices on the doors of each home along the street. Streets scheduled for milling and repaving are:

- 1) Highland Street from Hartford to 11th
- 2) Wilson Blvd from Fillmore to Highland
- 3) 18th Street from Hartford to Jackson
- 4) Herndon from 18th to 21st
- 5) 17th Street from Kirkwood to Hartford
- 6) Johnson Street: Cul de sac off 17th Street
- 7) Veitch Street from Key to Lee Highway

Streets scheduled for a slurry seal are:

- 1) Jackson Street from 13th to 17th
- 2) Adams Street from Key to Lee

2311 Wilson Blvd (Listrani's pizza site). The Site Plan Review Committee has not yet scheduled a meeting to consider designs for the relocated pedestrian path that currently bisects the site.

2401 Wilson Blvd. A series of Site Plan Review Committee meetings for a hotel and four singlefamily houses at Adams St. and Wilson Blvd. will be scheduled this spring.

Zom. Foundation work continues for this project at Washington Blvd. and Ivy St.

Lee Hwy. and Veitch St. townhouses. The final section of townhouses on this site is complete and all units are sold.

Washington Blvd. and Highland St. The foundation is almost complete and the pedestrian sheds are under construction.

James Hunter Park (aka "the dog park"). Construction continues at 13th St. and Herndon St.

Clarendon Metro Plaza. The first phase is complete. Materials are on site for repaying of the rest of the park to the war memorial.

History Watch a short video history of Lyon Village HERE. Most of Lyon Village was originally part of Robert Cruit's estate, which was purchased in 1846 and 1847 as a weekend and holiday retreat and later used as a dairy farm. The property was purchased by Frank Lyon on June 26, 1923 and divided into lots for real estate development. Approximately hirty-seven percent of the existing homes in Lyon Village were built in the 1920's, another thirty-six percent in the 1930's, and the remainder since 1940. The neighborhood is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.
